What is **Contentment**?

Contentment Means:

- Trusting God, not VISA.
- Being <u>Thankful</u> for all you have.
- Giving Generously in all circumstances.

Bottom Line: Trusting God will help you become content and experience true peace.

- 1. How is Financial Peace University affecting your life? How are you with money? Are you normal (broke)? Are you counter-cultural? How do you know?
- 2. We all like stuff! Some of us like cars or houses, others are into clothes or jewelry, still others prefer vacations and fancy meals. What 'stuff' are you into? What do you look to for happiness or satisfaction? How is that working for you?
- 3. Let's face it, contentment is not natural for us. In fact, dissatisfaction, and a idolatrous desire for "more" is in the mutated DNA of our falleness. Paul learned to say.... 'Jesus is better'....than the abundance of stuff. How about you? What or whom keeps you from being content? Have you learned yet that contentment is not related to our circumstances?
- 4. What are you thankful for most in your life? Who are you jealous or envious of because of what they have that you don't?
- 5. How generous are you? Not in your head and heart? But with your wallet and time? Who is confirming you are telling the truth?
