Community Group Questions

1. Read Hebrews 11:13-16. How is God faithful to those who died without receiving the fullness of the promise?
2. How did the heroes of faith in chapter 11 combat getting stuck in their present and past circumstances?
3. Where were some of the miracles for any of the heroes of faith that God used to “root them” completely in Him so that they trusted in Him?
4. Have you every had your path altered out of your control? How did you handle those moments? Would you declare now that God has been faithful to you through that season? Why or why not?
5. Read Hebrews 10:1-2; 12-14; 17-18. Why was the old Testament sacrificial system not sufficient for our justification? Why was Jesus' sacrifice sufficient?
6. What is the great promise in this scripture (vs 17)?
7. How does knowing that our sins will never be held against us [if we have faith in Jesus] give us the ability to follow Jesus?
8. Read Hebrews 10: 21-23; 32-39. Why do you think the writer of Hebrews consistently brings up endurance and perseverance in regards to our faith?
9. Does the promise of Jesus returning and that you have a final home with Him in heaven motivate you in this life to obey Him and trust Him? Why or why not?
10. What are ways God has provided for you in the past? How often do you reflect on these memories when it is hard to follow Jesus?
